Student Spotlight: Jessica Garcia

Hi there! My name is Jessica and I am from Hillsboro, Oregon. I am a senior in the College of Engineering and will graduate this Spring with an Honors Bachelor of Science in Computer Science with a Business minor. Throughout high school, I attended summer camps related to Arduino programming, wearable technology, and 3D printers. These hands-on and interactive experiences drove me to explore a career in computer science to improve technologies that solve challenges we face. During my first year at OSU, I was a part of the STEM Leaders Program, where I worked alongside a team of undergraduate students to develop computer science curriculum for K-12 students in Corvallis.

Before coming to OSU, I received a scholarship to participate in a year-long program in Germany where I had the opportunity to live with a host-family, participate in hands-on internships, and learn German. These learning experiences in Germany increased my interest in travel and language learning, which motivated me to study abroad during college. The summer after my freshman year, I was awarded the Gilman International and Critical Language Scholarships to study abroad in Seoul, South Korea where I was able to take courses related to my major and study Korean. Some of my most memorable experiences include participating in Taekwondo after school, making life-long friendships with international and local students, and learning to navigate the public transportation system in a new country. After Korea, I participated in a faculty-led program in London and spent a semester abroad in France during my sophomore year as a Ford Scholar. I would strongly encourage students of all majors to consider studying or interning abroad for a lifetime of memories and a unique global perspective.

Being a part of TRIO has been rewarding from the beginning. As a first-generation student, joining TRIO my freshman year allowed me to smoothly transition to OSU. One of my fondest memories in TRIO includes the Summer Bridge program through which I was able to connect with my TRIO advisor, build a community, and familiarize myself with campus before classes began. I would advise students to participate in the tutoring program, meet regularly with their TRIO advisor, and seek ways to get involved both on and off campus through research, clubs, internships, and networking events-- the opportunities are endless!
